#### **Free School Meals**

While all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 currently receive universal free school meals, some families may be entitled to income related free school meals for their children. We would really like to encourage parents to apply for these if they are entitled to them, as this triggers a payment called Pupil Premium Grant to our school, which is currently worth £1,345 per child and is paid annually for the entirety of their time with us, whether they continue to receive free school meals or not. This enables us to better support children with their learning and make sure that every child fulfils their potential. If your child is in ANY year group and you think that you might be entitled to income-related free school meals, please take a minute to read the information here and then call the number to apply.
